Today I am going to The Children's Museum of Sonoma County.



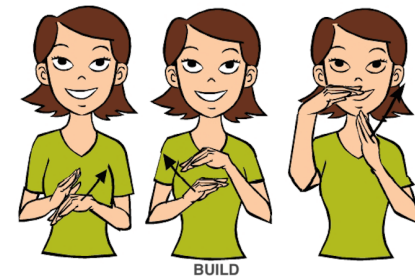
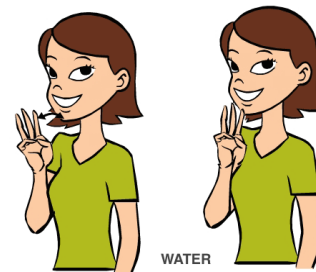
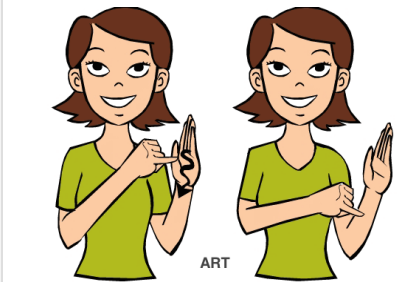
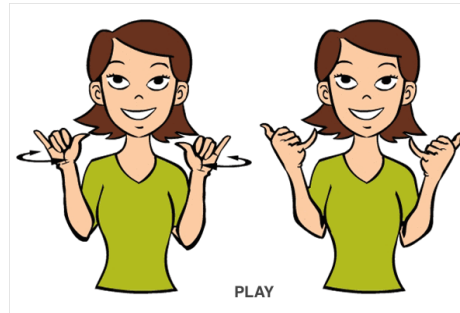
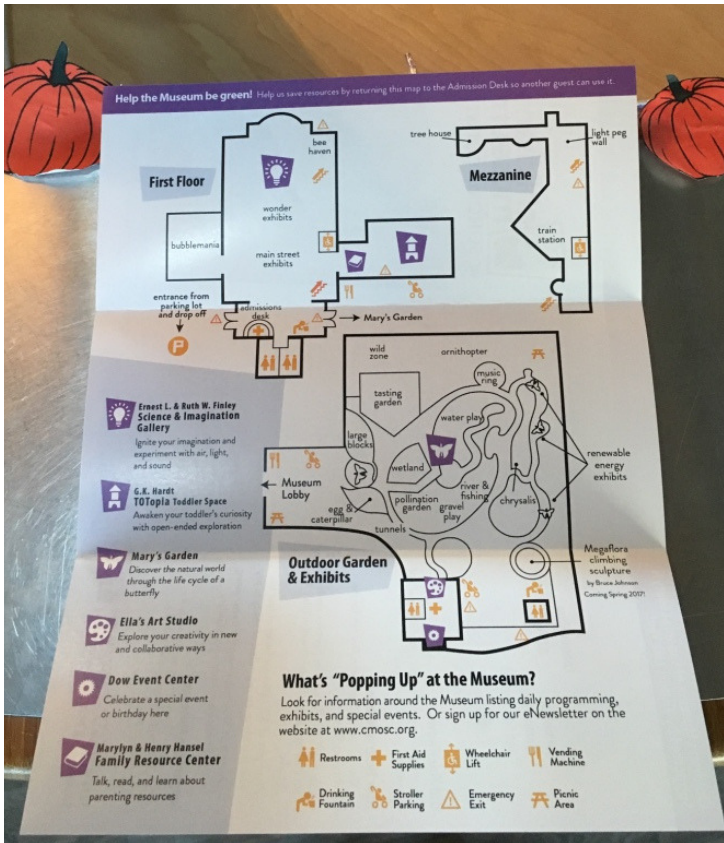
When I get to the Children's Museum I will walk to the front door.

Outside, I will see a small river where I can play with water and plastic fish. It is OK if I get a little wet.



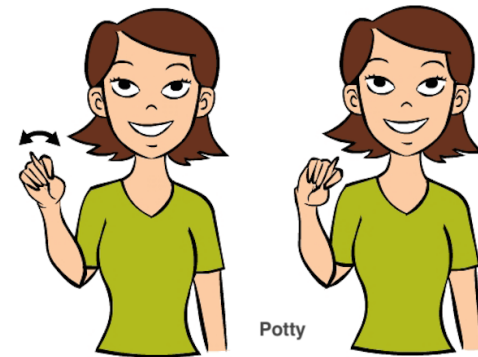
I cannot put my feet in the water outside.
